AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH PAVEMENT TECHNOLOGY, INC. FOR THE APPLICATION OF RECLAMITE ON SELECTED CITY STREETS AS INCLUDED AS PART OF THE 2021 BUDGET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on January 11, 2021 this Council passed the 2021 Capital Budget and Expenditures Ordinance (20-102), appropriating One Million, Five Hundred Forty-Four Thousand, Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,544,200.00) from the General Capital Improvement Fund (400) for Road Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the needed materials and services are available utilizing the ODOT State Bid 101L-22 contract; and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Pavement Technology, Inc., 24144 Detroit Road, Westlake, Ohio 44145 for the purchase of Asphalt Rejuvenating Agent - RECLAMITE materials and services for the following:

The agreement shall be in a form approved by the Director of Law, and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to pay said contract price from funds appropriated for the purpose.

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide road surface treatments, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
