AN ORDINANCE

**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE
CUYAHOGA COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH TO PROVIDE PHASE II
STORMWATER SERVICES TO THE CITY OF BAY VILLAGE DURING CALENDAR
YEARS 2022 THROUGH 2023, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, The Cuyahoga County Board of Health (CCBH) maintains a Stormwater Program that assists the City in meeting the Ohio EPA's Phase II Stormwater requirements, and;

WHEREAS, the previous Memorandum of Understanding between CCBH and the City for participation in the Stormwater Program will expire on December 31, 2021, and the City would like to continue its participation in the program;


NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Cuyahoga County Board of Health to provide Phase II Stormwater services to the City of Bay Village for and during the calendar years 2022 through 2023 at a cost to the City of Five Thousand, Eight Hundred Eighteen Dollars (\$5,818.00) for calendar year 2022, and Five Thousand, Eight Hundred Eighteen Dollars (\$5,818.00) for calendar year 2023 for a total compensation of \$11,636.00.

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.


