

ORDINANCE NO. 21-86

AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
CENTENNIAL CONTRACTORS ENTERPRISES, INC. FOR
THE DWYER MEMORIAL CENTER MASONRY REPAIRS PROJECT,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Dwyer Memorial Center is in need of masonry repairs, and

WHEREAS, the City is a participant in a cooperative purchasing program called Equalis;
and

WHEREAS, Equalis offers contracted construction services through job order contracts, which are a method of providing competitively bid unit costs for a construction tasks which satisfies the public bidding requirements of the State of Ohio and allows participants to streamline project development and procurement of services;


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Centennial Contractors Enterprises, Inc., 4500 Rockside Road Suite 110, Independence, OH 44131, for the Dwyer Memorial Center Masonry Repairs Project, in accordance with plans and specifications issued. The total awarded contract price is Fifty Thousand, Ninety-Six Dollars and Eighty-Seven Cents (\$50,096.87), the price for contingency work is Two Thousand, Five Hundred Ninety-Three Dollars and Seventy-Nine Cents (\$2,593.79), for a potential total contract amount of Fifty-Two Thousand, Six Hundred Ninety Dollars and Sixty-Six Cents (\$52,690.66).

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason to ensure that construction will take place as soon as possible, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


