

ORDINANCE NO. 21-83

AN ORDINANCE
**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A ONE YEAR CONTRACT
WITH THE JEFFERSON HEALTH PLAN TO PROVIDE ADMINISTRATIVE
SERVICES FOR THE CITY'S HEALTH AND HOSPITALIZATION PLAN,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the current agreement between the City of Bay Village and Jefferson Health Plan to provide services as a third party administrator for the City's self-funded health and hospitalization plan expires December 31, 2021;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. The City of Bay Village hereby agrees to enter into a one year contract with The Jefferson Health Plan and agrees to pay premiums monthly for specific stop-loss insurance, referred to as the Large Claim Reimbursement Program to be provided by The Jefferson Plan.

SECTION 2. The City of Bay Village agrees to pay a monthly premium to The Jefferson Health Plan to be allocated to pay claims incurred by employees and covered dependents as required by the contract with The Jefferson Health Plan.

SECTION 3. The City of Bay Village agrees to pay an administrative charge to The Jefferson Health Plan per covered employee per month.


SECTION 4. The Jefferson Health Plan shall provide specific stop-loss coverage in the amount of \$75,000.00 for each person covered by the City's health insurance plan.

SECTION 5. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 6. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to continue to provide for medical and hospitalization coverage for City employees in conformance with labor agreements, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
