AN ORDINANCE
**AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH ADS ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES FOR
FLOW MONITORING SERVICES RELATED TO THE CLOSURE OF THE
SANITARY SEWER OVERFLOWS (SSOS) PER UNITED STATES
ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ORDERS OF CONSENT,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Village requested proposals for flow and rainfall monitoring to collect data needed to refine our current hydraulic model in preparation for the closure of two SSOs as required by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Orders of Consent; and

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the City Engineer, it has been determined that the best proposal for the monitoring services is from ADS Environmental Services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with ADS Environmental Services, 340 The Bridge Street, Suite 204, Huntsville, AL 35806, to proceed with professional services relative to flow and rainfall monitoring. Said work is to be performed under contract at a cost not to exceed Seventy-Four Thousand, Two Hundred Dollars (\$74,200.00)

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, property and safety, and for the further reason that flow and rain monitoring may go forward expeditiously, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
