AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE CHAPTER 923.04
REGARDING REFUSE COLLECTION PENALTY FOR LATE PAYMENT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Codified Ordinance Chapter 923.04 which presently reads as follows:

923.04 - PENALTY FOR LATE PAYMENT.

All unpaid charges for Section 923.01 and Section 921.02 shall be certified by the Director of Finance to the Auditor of Cuyahoga County for collection as other municipal taxes. A penalty of ten percent of the delinquent amount shall be added to delinquent accounts, but in no event shall such penalty be less than \$10.00. Should one or both of the charges in Section 923.01 or Section 921.02 not be paid, only one \$10.00 late fee shall apply. An account shall be deemed delinquent if not paid by the end of the quarterly collection periods specified in Section 923.02 and Section 921.03. (Ord. 08-51. Passed 5-19-08.)

923.04 - PENALTY FOR LATE PAYMENT.

All unpaid charges for Section 923.01 and Section 921.02 shall be certified by the Director of Finance to the Auditor of Cuyahoga County for collection as other municipal taxes. A penalty of \$25.00 shall be added to delinquent accounts. Should one or both of the charges in Section 923.01 or Section 921.02 not be paid, only one \$25.00 penalty shall apply. An account shall be deemed delinquent if not paid by the end of the quarterly collection periods specified in Section 923.02 and Section 921.03.


and present 923.04 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
