

ORDINANCE NO. 22-63

ORDINANCE
**DESIGNATING A PORTION OF WOLF ROAD AS ONE WAY DURING THE
RESURFACING PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, on December 21, 2020 Council passed Ordinance 20-100 authorizing an agreement with Cuyahoga County for the resurfacing a portion of Wolf Road; and

WHEREAS, resurfacing a portion of Wolf Road will begin in June, 2022; and

WHEREAS, restricting travel on Wolf Road to one way heading east will expedite this construction project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.O. 305.04 the Mayor has the authority to temporarily restrict the use of any street for longer than 90 days with approval of Council;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor hereby designates Wolf Road from Dover Center Road to Clague Road to be one way with eastern travel only for the duration of the Wolf Road resurfacing project and this Council approves of the same.


SECTION 2. That the Traffic Control Map of the City is hereby temporarily amended to designate the prohibitions as stated, and the Traffic Control File is hereby temporarily amended to provide for the erection of the "One Way" signs at appropriate locations.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
