A RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN URBAN CANOPY RESTORATION GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) Division of Forestry Urban Canopy Restoration Grant Program addresses the critical need to restore and improve urban forests, and build resiliency through tree planting in urban communities where trees are critical to human health; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Village desires financial assistance under this program to improve the City's tree canopy, and will prepare the grant application for submission;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio;

SECTION 1. That Council hereby authorizes the application to ODNR for financial assistance in an amount not to exceed \$12,500.00, provision of all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance, and execution of any agreements necessary to receive any awarded funds.

SECTION 2. That Council hereby agrees to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the grant program, and a local match equal to the grant award, not to exceed \$12,500.00.

SECTION 3. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 4. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is necessary to authorize the filing of said application in a timely manner, wherefore this resolution shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
