**ORDINANCE**  
**AMENDING ORDINANCE 22-94 REGARDING REPAIRS TO THE POLICE STATION  
PARKING LOT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, on August 22, 2022, this Council passed Ordinance 22-94 authorizing an agreement with Carron Asphalt Paving, Inc. with a contract amount of One Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand, Four Hundred Fifty-Eight Dollars (\$164,458.00), as a proposed amount for the City Parking Lot Resurfacing Project; and

**WHEREAS**, due to a change in the scope of work, the actual amount is Two Hundred Sixteen Thousand, Four Hundred Three Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$216,403.50);

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio;

**SECTION 1.** That the sum of Two Hundred Sixteen Thousand, Four Hundred Three Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$216,403.50) is hereby approved for the improvement described above and Carron Asphalt Paving, Inc. is authorized to proceed with the additional repairs for the Police Station Parking Lot Repaving Project.

**SECTION 2.** That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

**SECTION 3.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
