AN ORDINANCE

**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
FIRSTENERGY SOLUTIONS CORP. (FES), FOR THE SUPPLY
OF UTILITY SERVICES TO THE INHABITANTS OF THE CITY OF
BAY VILLAGE AS GOVERNMENTAL AGGREGATORS,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, by and through Ordinance No. 10-13 Council authorized all necessary actions to effect a governmental electricity aggregation program pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, on May 4th, 2010, the electors of the City of Bay Village voted to approve the City's authority to aggregate for the provision of competitive retail electric service; and

WHEREAS, by and through Ordinance 19-44 Council authorized Amendment to the Electric Power Aggregation Plan of Operation and Governance regulating competitive retail electric service; and

WHEREAS, the City's consultant Sustainable Energy Services Inc. recommends that an agreement be entered into with FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. (FES), for the supply of utility services to the inhabitants of the City of Bay Village as governmental aggregators;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and she is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. (FES), for the supply of utility services to the residents of the City of Bay Village as more fully set forth in the Master Agreement on file with the City of Bay Village with such revisions which may be approved by the Mayor and the Director of Law.

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason to establish a program for competitive utility services, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
